



James Russell Anderson

James Russell Anderson (called "Jim" or "Russell") was born 7 Apr 1923 near Macedon, Mercer County, Ohio. He served during W. W. II with the 1st Platoon, Company A, 114th Infantry Regiment, 44th Division of the U.S. Army. He was killed in action 3 Dec 1944 at Volksberg, Department of Bas-Rhin, in Alsace, France. After his death Russ was buried near the village of Hochfelden, France. Then after the war his body was brought home and he now rests beside his parents in Swamp College Cemetery. He was the son of Albert Boyd and Martha Jane Anderson of 812 Wilkins Street, Celina. All five of the family's sons, one of their daughters and all three of their sons-in-law served in either W.W. II or the Korean War. Also serving with Russell in Company A was Robert Shaffer of Rockford, Ohio, who was killed in action December 5.
